

ENGLISH HONOURS REQUIREMENTS for students beginning the program before Fall 2010

***If you are using Degree Navigator, ensure that you have selected the correct admission year from the menu provided at the top of your screen**
An FCE is a full-course equivalent or 6 credits/units. An HCE is a half-course equivalent or 3 credits/units. You must complete a minimum of 10 and maximum of 12 full course equivalents (FCEs) = 20-24 half course equivalents (HCEs) in English and 20 FCEs in your degree overall to graduate.*

>>Start by taking 3.0 FCEs in the appropriate Foundation Program [<https://english.ucalgary.ca/content/programs-and-requirements>]

Complete 4.0 FCE (8.0 HCE) at the 400 level, including

>>1 FCE (2 HCE) from these three categories, ideally from one:**

- ENGL 401—Old English Language and Prose Literature
- ENGL 403—Old English Poetry
- ENGL 405—Middle English Literature: *The Canterbury Tales*
- ENGL 406—Middle English Literature: Other Genres

- ENGL 409—Early Tudor Literature
- ENGL 410—Elizabethan Poetry and Prose
- ENGL 411—17th Century Poetry and Prose
- ENGL 412—Elizabethan Drama
- ENGL 413—Seventeenth Century Drama

- ENGL 431 – Literature of the Restoration
- ENGL 433 – Literature of the Early 18th Century
- ENGL 435 – Literature of the Later 18th Century

>> and 1 FCE (2 HCE) from these three categories, ideally from one:**

- ENGL 441—Literature of the Romantic Period: Revolution
- ENGL 443—Literature of the Romantic Period: Reform
- ENGL 445— Literature of the Early Victorian Period
- ENGL 447—Literature of the Mid-Victorian Period
- ENGL 449—Literature of the Late Victorian Period

- ENGL 449 Literature of the Late Victorian Period
- ENGL 451 – British Literature from 1900 to 1950
- ENGL 453 – British Literature since 1950

- ENGL 461—Early American Literature and American Renaissance
- ENGL 463— American Literature Late 1800's-mid 1900's
- ENGL 465—American Literature from 1950

>>and: 2 additional FCE (4 HCE) at the 400-level

****Note that prior to Fall 2010, these categories were made up of full-year courses with different**

>>Other requirements

- 1.0 FCE ENGL 504 – Honours Project and Seminar
- 1.0 FCE at the 500-level, your choice
- 1.0 HCE in Canadian Literature (371, 372, 471, 473, 509, special topics)
- 2.0-4.0 FCE Your choice from other English courses at the 300-level or above
- 2.0 FCE in a language other than English. 1.0 FCE must be at the 300-level or higher

NOTES:

1. To receive a creative writing concentration you complete 3 FCEs from the following courses: English 364, 366, 494, 496, 598, and courses offered in Drama (see below). Admission is based on the submission of a portfolio in August. English Honours students can satisfy one FCE in creative writing by taking English 504 with a creative writing project. You must request from the Student Success Centre the designation "Creative Writing Concentration" for your transcript.
2. 1 FCE from courses outside the department may be counted towards the major, including COLT 371, 405, 471, 517, LING 321, LING 435 and Drama 371, 471, 572.01, 572.29, or HUMN 405.
