

ENGLISH HONOURS REQUIREMENTS For students beginning their program in Fall 2010 – Spring 2012

***If you are using Degree Navigator, ensure that you have selected the correct admission year from the menu provided at the top of your screen**
An FCE is a full-course equivalent or 6 credits/units. An HCE is a half-course equivalent or 3 credits/units. You must complete a minimum of 10 and maximum of 12 full course equivalents (FCEs) = 20-24 half course equivalents (HCEs) in English and 20 FCEs in your degree overall to graduate.*

- 1.0 HCE Canadian Literature (371, 372, 471, 473, 509, special topics)
- 1.0 HCE Postcolonial Studies (ENGL 385, 391, 490, 491, 493, 515, special topics)
- 1.0 FCE ENGL 504 – Honours Project and Seminar
- 1.0 FCE Your choice from the 500-level
- 2.0-4.0 FCE Your choice from other English courses at the 300-level or above
- 2.0 FCE in a language other than English. One FCE must be at least 300-level.

NOTES:

1. To receive a creative writing concentration you complete 3 FCEs from the following courses: English 364, 366, 494, 496, 598, and courses offered in Drama (see below). Admission is based on the submission of a portfolio in August. English Honours students can satisfy one FCE in creative writing by taking English 504 with a creative writing project. You must request from the Student Success Centre the designation "Creative Writing Concentration" for your transcript.
2. 1 FCE from courses outside the department may be counted towards the major, including COLT 371, 405, 471, 517, LING 321, LING 435 and Drama 371, 471, 572.01 or 572.29, HUMN 405.
