## **ENGLISH MINOR REQUIREMENTS**

**To graduate with a Minor in English, you must complete 5.0 (and no more than 6.0) full course equivalents (FCEs) in English. All minors must complete the English Foundation Program. Please refer to the listing below for the precise requirements of the Foundation Program according to year.**

**Students Who Began Their Program Before Winter 2009 must take these courses:**

ENGL 240 (Literature in English from the Middle Ages to the Present)

ENGL 354 (Poetry: Reading and Analysis)

ENGL 302 (Introduction to Contemporary Theoretical Practices)

**Students Who Began Their Program between Fall 2009-Winter 2013 must take these courses:**

ENGL 203 (Foundations: Literary Analysis)

ENGL 205(Foundations: Shakespeare)

ENGL 302 (Foundations: Introduction to Contemporary Theoretical Practices)

ENGL 340 (Foundations: Literature in English from the Middle Ages to the Present)

**Students Who Began Their Program in Fall 2013 or later must take these courses:**

ENGL 205 or ENGL 311

ENGL 302 (Foundations: Introduction to Contemporary Theoretical Practices)

ENGL 340 (Foundations: Literature in English from the Middle Ages to the Present)

Note: In order to enroll in ENGL 302 and ENGL 340, students must have taken 1 FCE previously in English. We recommend that students take ENGL 201 and ENGL 205/311 in order to complete this requirement.

**In additional to the foundation courses listed above, ALL English Minors must taken an additional**

**2.0 FCEs in English courses at the 300-level and above**

NOTE: Students may not receive credit for more than one full course equivalent of 200-level English. The only exception is when English 240 is taken after another 200-level English course or courses, in which case the student may receive credit for up to two full-course equivalents in 200-level English.
